Goal: Better decisions in participation

- Evaluation of active or completed participations
 - ☐ Better fact-based information
- Faster and more accurate creation of participations
 - ☐ More democracy/participation for the people
- Testing language models and their ability to summarize large amounts of text
 - ☐ Sensible use of AI

Problems and risks



- Democracy depends on people working together: we do not want to use technology to give people the feeling that individual opinions and points of view are being changed or "interpreted" in automated processes.
- Al does not always have an easy image, it is not expedient to transfer possible acceptance problems of Al to substantive aspects, then democracy suffers.
- When using AI in a summary or presentation, a "machine" ultimately decides what is presented in the presentation because not all shades can be listed. Great care must be taken to ensure full transparency.
